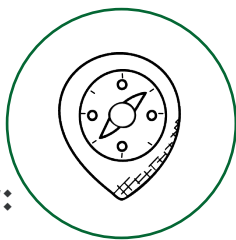


IMPORTANT to know:

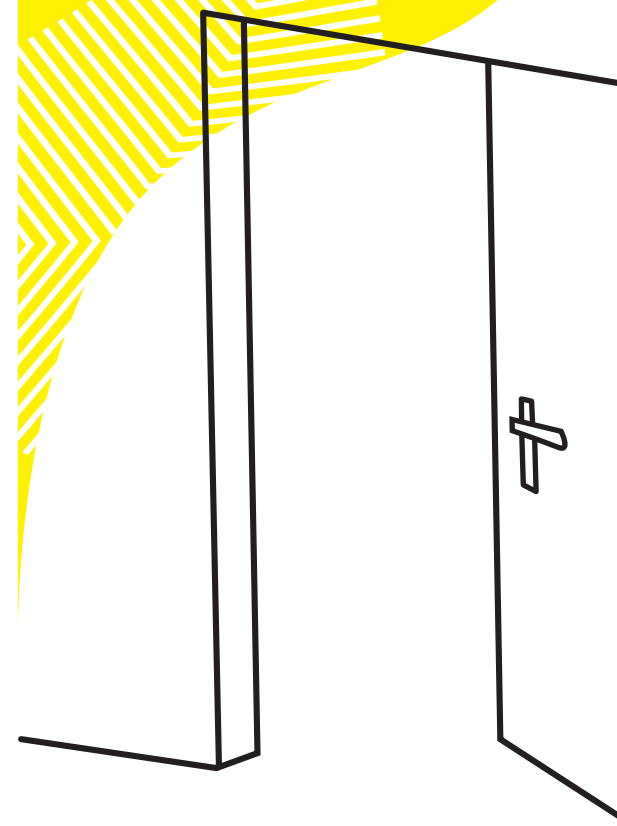

WHAT is KOBRA?

„KOBRA stands for strength,
transformation ability,
self-confidence.“

KOBRA has been a focused specialist counseling center in Stuttgart for over 30 years. Children and juveniles who have experienced sexualized violence, their caregivers as well as specialized personnel and volunteers who work with children and juveniles are advised here.



WHO is KOBRA?

We are an interdisciplinary team. Five counsellors, a management and an administrative staff work at KOBRA. We set off with you. We accompany handling the experience of sexualized violence. It is important to us that everyone who consults us feels to be taken seriously with one's concerns and we try to develop a future perspective together.

WHAT is offered by KOBRA?

- Advice and supervision for children and juveniles (with and without disabilities) and their caregivers in the case of sexualized violence.
- Online advice for children and juveniles. Registration via our website.
- Advice to specialists (amongst others: guidance of specialists who are experienced in this respect (ieF) on the scope of sexualized violence).
- Advice to young people who have behaved sexually invasive.
- Further education and training on sexualized violence (you can find current offers at our homepage).
- Case supervision for specialists.
- Support in the development of protection concepts.

Prevention for different target groups.

- Elementary education (kindergartens and day-care centers / ages 3 to 6)
- Primary school (4th Class)
- Secondary school (7th Class)

WHO can contact KOBRA?

- Children and juveniles (with and without disabilities) who have experienced sexualized violence
- Educators and caregivers
- Specialists from the scope of schools, day-care centers, institutions for child and youth welfare
- Institution managements in the scope of education and care
- Specialists in training
- Volunteers who work with children and juveniles etc.
